

RoHS AND RoHS2 COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

RoHS (Restriction of Hazardous Substances), is an EU directive on the restriction of certain hazardous substances within electrical and electronic equipment, which was brought into force on 13 February 2003.

With the introduction of the RoHS directive in February 2003 and the adoption of RoHS 2 in June 2011 as well as the proposed implementation commencement of July 2014, 1st Millennium Electronics Limited can confirm compliance with European Directive 2002/95/EC and RoHS II 2011/65/EU and all subsequent amendments.

All standard products including complimentary materials contained in our standard product ranges bright zinc plated steel, plastic patch, nylon inserts, beryllium copper etc. are compliant with RoHS 2002/95/EC and do not contain over the designated threshold of any banned substances. These include:

Cadmium 100 ppm (0.01% weight)

Decabromine diphenyl ether (DECA BDE) 1000 ppm (0.1% weight)

Hexavalent Chromium 1000 ppm (0.1% weight)

Lead * 1000 ppm (0.1% weight)

Mercury 1000 ppm (0.1% weight)

Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) 1000 ppm (0.1% weight)

Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) 1000 ppm (0.1% weight)
